### The Bell of Hope

"Cast from shackles which bound them, this bell shall ring out hope for the mentally ill and victory over mental illness."



You may frequently see a bell referenced in Mental Health America of Southwestern PA materials — it even appears in our logo. This bell is very symbolic to the mental health movement. During the early days of mental health treatment, asylums restrained mental health patients using chains and shackles. After this practice was stopped in the 1950s, Mental Health America issued a call for asylums across the country to send them their discarded chains and shackles. These symbols of inhumane treatment were then melted down and recast in the form of a bell — a symbol of hope.

This powerful symbol is also part of Mental Health America of Southwestern PA's Bell of Hope campaign. By donating to the Bell of Hope you are providing hope to individuals experiencing mental health and substance use issues.

Mental Health America of Southwestern PA (MHA-SWPA) has worked to fight the stigma associated with mental illness through outreach and educational efforts for 57 years. MHA of Southwestern PA provides educational programs that help individuals learn about mental wellness and substance use as well as explain the challenges of depression, bipolar disorder, other types of mental illness, and those impacted by addiction and suicide loss.
